We have lots of ideas we hope will help continue to enable the pre-school to thrive and provide a safe welcoming setting for the children to enjoy.

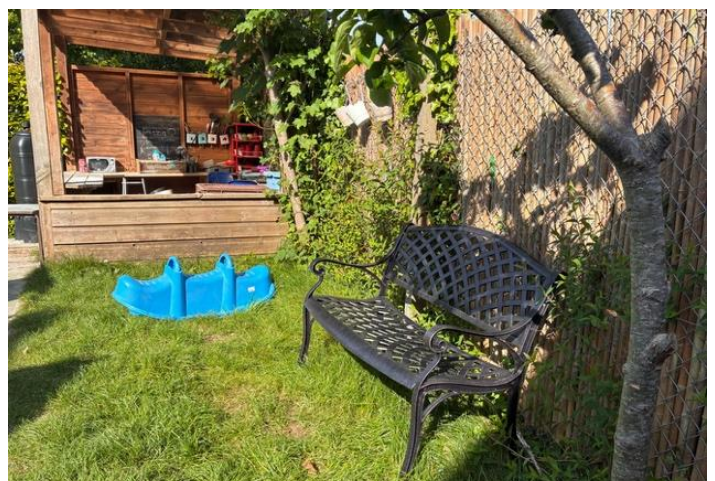
## Current Fundraising Targets:
